- Establish, maintain, monitor, review, audit and continually improve the company's management system consistent with the requirements of ISO 45001:2018 Occupational Health & Safety Management System.
- Establish, review and communicate measurable objectives and targets to ensure enhancement of our Safety Management System.
- Comply with all work health and safety acts and all other applicable laws, regulations, codes of practise, compliance codes and standards that may impact the workplace.
- Through regular training, inductions, and consultation, encourage all employees to integrate safe methods into the way we work.
- Consult with employees to participate and identify OHS risk and opportunities to continually improve the Safety Management System.
- Embrace worker feedback and implement actions to enhance continual improvement.
- Ensure all incidents are reported, investigated and learned from to minimise reoccurrence.
- Ensure identified hazards are assessed, investigated, acted on and eliminated where possible, including identifying and acting on psychosocial hazards.
- Provide leadership with safety policy in strategic, business and operational planning.
